THIS MATTER coming before the undersigned Judge presiding over the May 26, 2009 civil session of Wake County Superior Court upon application by plaintiff for entry of a Preliminary Injunction under N.C. Gen. Statutes § 75-14 and Rule 65 of the Rules of Civil Procedure prohibiting defendants Tamir Avraham and Locksmith Services, Inc. from holding themselves out as locksmiths or providing locksmith services within the state; and Assistant Attorneys General Kimberly Wierzel and David N. Kirkman appearing on behalf of plaintiff State of North Carolina; and no one appearing on behalf of said defendants; and it appearing to the Court from plaintiff's deceptive trade practices Complaint, the documents and affidavits submitted to the Court, the arguments of counsel and the requirements in the Locksmith Licensing Act, N.C. Gen. Statutes § 74F-1, *et seq.*, that plaintiff is likely to prevail on the merits in this action and that the terms of the Temporary Restraining Order should be continued in force and effect against said defendants as a Preliminary Injunction so that further violations of law and further harm to the public will not occur pending final resolution of this cause;

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that defendants Tamir Avraham and Locksmith Services, Inc., together with their respective agents, employees, corporate officers, contractors, corporate successors and assigns, as well as any third party call centers, internet service companies and parties acting in concert with either of said defendants having knowledge hereof,

be and hereby are Preliminarily Enjoined, pending final resolution of this cause, from: 1) offering or providing locksmith services (including "lock-out" services) in North Carolina without possessing a license issued by the North Carolina Locksmith Licensing Board; 2) advertising or otherwise holding themselves out as locksmiths who can provide services to North Carolina residents and businesses unless and until they possess a license issued by the North Carolina Locksmith Licensing Board; 3) accepting calls from North Carolina residents or businesses seeking locksmith or lock-out services without first possessing a license issued by the North Carolina Locksmith Licensing Board; and 4) upon obtaining a license issued by the North Carolina Locksmith Licensing Board, failing to include their locksmith license number in any and all advertisements or failing to ensure that only licensed locksmiths are sent to customers' homes, businesses or vehicles to perform locksmith and lock-out services;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that nothing in this Preliminary Injunction shall prejudice the rights of defendants Anna Konevsky, 704 Locksmith, Inc. or NC Charlotte Locksmith, Inc. to challenge or oppose plaintiff's application for a Preliminary Injunction against them, which matter is scheduled to be taken up by the Court on June 4, 2009.
